Measure selected for improvement; reason for selection</b>	As a pediatric practice, our patients are considered to be one of the more vulnerable patient populations when it comes to the Flu virus. For this reason, we feel that it is important to continually focus on improving our numbers with regards to patients that receive this important immunization

	<b>6. Assess actions; describe improvement</b>	Although we did not meet the numeric goal, there was a 2.88% improvement of patients receiving influenza vaccinations. The patient population also increased by 116 patients during the re-measurement period.

(QI 12)</b>	During the one month re-measurement period from August 2017 to September 2017, there was a 9.17% increase of patients who received nutritional counseling at each well check. The patient population also increased by 58 patients during the re-measurement period.
